- B. This is my commandment: love one another, as I have loved you

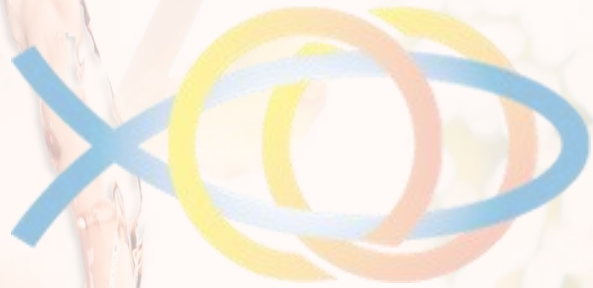
